Fet's learn how to make sushi from a real-life sushi chef.... And then let's enjoy eating together!




#### Friday 17th April JAPANESE INDIGO DYEING!


## **Course Fee**

At Hokkaido JaLS you can participate for as little as one week. Students participating for more than 4 weeks will receive a 10% discount, commencing at week 5. You can also join us for study on a regular course before or after the spring schedule and be eligible for discounted study. Please contact us for more information.

### Fee 36,200 JPY per week

\* There is a 10% discount for students participating for more than 4 weeks, commencing at week 5.

Fee Example: Participating in the spring course for 6 weeks, and continuing to study on the standard course to make a total of 8 weeks.
