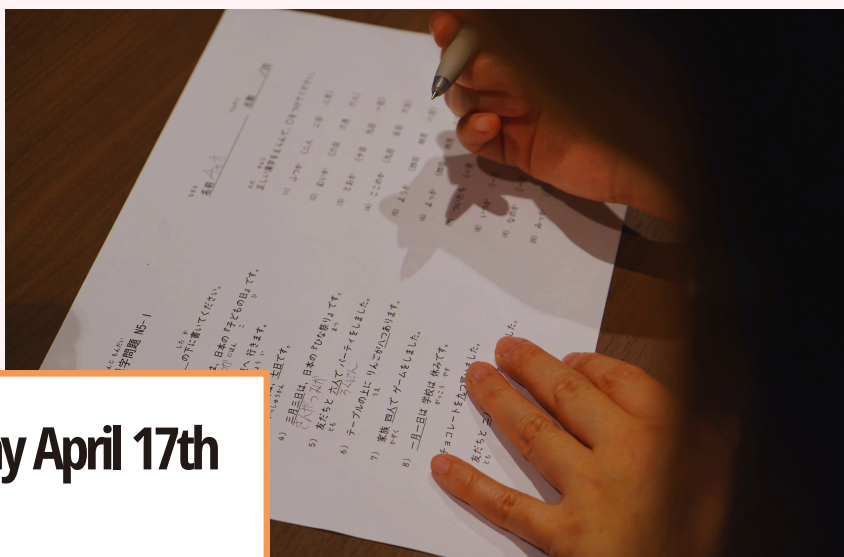
Registration
