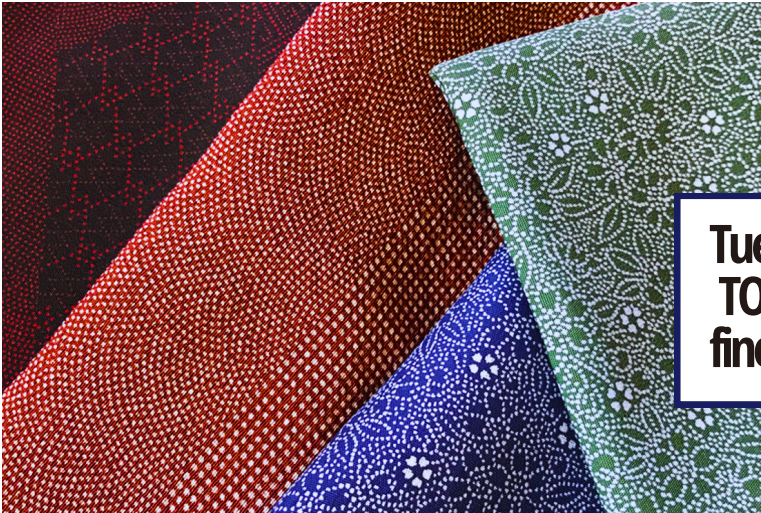
# Japanese Culture Lessons

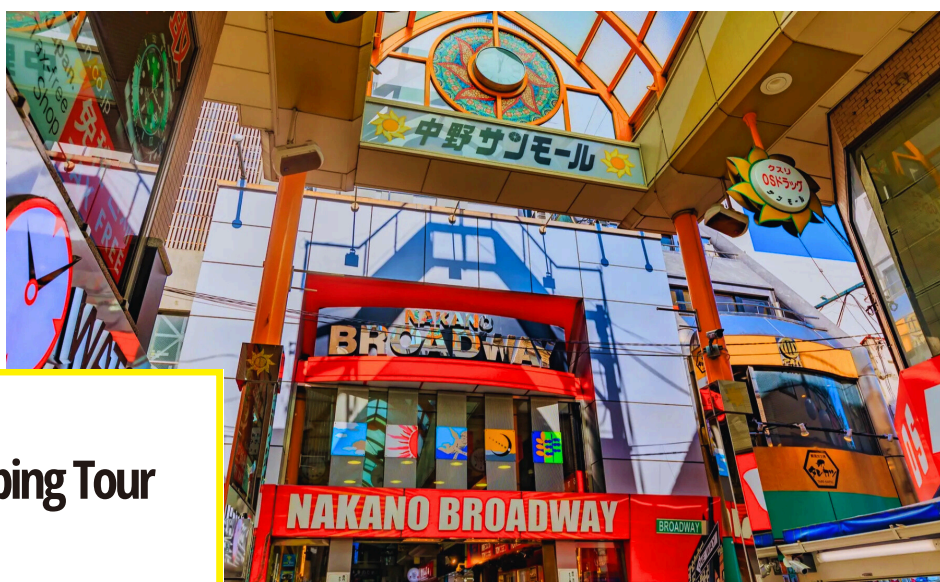
